Spring Break Kids Drop-in Program at Delta Museum

Suggested for children ages 7-12, the popular children's fun-filled adventure is a drop-in, self-guided tour program offered by the Delta Museum and Archives Society during Spring Break. The program runs March 17 – 22 and March 24 – 27 during regular museum hours of 9:30 am to 4:30 pm, Tuesday to Friday. Children under 7 years are welcome to participate but may need additional parental assistance. Cost is \$5.00 per mystery-solving kit.
