NOTICE OF FILMING

Dear Neighbours of **6522 Holly Park Drive**,

Based on the positive results of a poll we conducted in your neighbourhood, the Corporation of Delta has granted Supernatural 5 Films Inc. permission to film scenes for the TV Series "Supernatural" on Tuesday December 2 2014 until 11:00pm and Wednesday, December 3 until 3:30 am (Thursday, December 4). We thank you for supporting the B.C. film industry and our project.

Supernatural 5 Films Inc. would like to provide you with some information to help you prepare for our arrival and anticipate how our presence may affect your daily routine.

Tuesday, December 2

7:00am – 10:30am

- Our crew prepares the location for filming.

10:30am - 11:00pm

- We film day and night exterior dialogue scenes at 6522 Holly Park Drive, where a couple of actors will be talking and a car pulls up the house.
- This night scene will require 5 lighting positions. One will be positioned in Kensington court on private property, one will be positioned on the West side of 64 street near the intersection to Holly Park Drive one will be positioned on the East side of 65a street on private property, one will be positioned in the lot by the tennis courts and one will be positioned on the West side of 66 street. We will make every effort to direct the light towards our scenes; however, the area will appear brighter than usual. **There will be NO gunfire or special effects; however, atmospheric smoke will be used.**

11:00pm –12:00am (Wednesday, December 3)

- Equipment is packed into the trucks; the trucks stay overnight and the crew leaves the neighbourhood quietly.

Wednesday, December 3

7:00am – 12:00pm

- Our crew prepares the location for filming.

12:00pm – 4:00pm

- We film interior dialogue scenes at 6522 Holly Park Drive with two actors.

4:00pm – 3:30am (Thursday, December 4)

- We move to the front of the house and film an exterior scene with a car stunt. There will be NO gunfire; however the scene will include a car driving down the road and crashing into an electrical pole – the pole will be a prop specifically designed by our crew and atmospheric smoke will be used.
- **To help facilitate our stunt and provide safety we will have the Delta Police Department on site. The officers will close the road for the stunt scene on Holly Park Drive from 64 Street to 66 Street. ONLY LOCAL TRAFFIC will have access through but may be asked to wait a few minutes while we perform our stunt.**
- **The bus will be re-routed for the stunt scene and will NOT be running through Holly Park Drive from 66 Street to 64 Street on Wednesday, December 3 from 3:00pm to 4:00am (Thursday, December 4). The bus will continue onto Ladner Trunk Road and 64 Street. (See Reverse for Map)**
- This night scene will require 5 lighting positions. One will be positioned in Kensington court on private property, one will be positioned on the West side of 64 street near the intersection to Holly Park Drive, one will be positioned on the East side of 65a street on private property, one will be positioned in the lot by the tennis courts and one will be positioned on the West side of 66 street. We will make every effort to direct the light towards our scenes; however, the area will appear brighter than usual.

3:30am – 4:00am (Thursday, December 4)

- Equipment is packed into the trucks and the crew leaves the neighbourhood quietly.

Our production will post "**Temporary No Stopping**" signs in the following areas and times

Tuesday, December 2 from 7:00 am to 4:00 am Thursday, December 4

- Both sides of 66 Street from the entrance of PL 6574
- North side of Holly Park Drive at PL 6521

Tuesday, December 2 from 10:00 am to 10:00 am Thursday, December 4

- West side of 64 Street from PL 4667 to 4663

We emphasize that changes in parking are temporary and appreciate your cooperation in using alternative parking during this time. **All parking will be released as it becomes available.** We will ensure any residents with special needs are accommodated promptly.
